**24.** Telephonist, Signals Company, Red Army Soldier Suryaninov Aleksandr Andreevich, for [the following]: On March 18, 1944, in battle for the villages [*sic*] of Kruki, Verbsky District, Rivne Oblast, under enemy fire, risking his life, he quickly repaired 15 breaks in the communication lines.
