The medal “For Courage” to:

2. Guards Junior Sergeant Bezsonny Viktor Pavlovich, gunner of 120 mm mortar battery, who during the engagement against the German invaders near the lake Sviblo, with well placed fire of his mortar, he suppressed an enemy artillery battery, which was delivering direct fire over the ice covered lake and thus, didn't allow any movement across it.

In the battle for the village of Ivashkovo, he suppressed the fire of 2 enemy machine gun positions on the hill and dispersed up to 12 German soldiers.

Born in 1923, Ukrainian, not a party member, inducted into the Red Army in 1942 by
Chertkovsky Regional Military Commissariat.
